HUMPHREY FELLOWS HOST GLOBAL FORUM

Davis, Calif. — This year's Hubert Humphrey Fellowship Global Forum takes place this Thursday, August 14, at the International House in Davis. The Humphrey program brings accomplished mid-career professionals from designated countries in Africa, Asia, Latin America, the Caribbean, the Middle East and Eurasia to the U.S. for a year of graduate study and related professional experience.

President Jimmy Carter instituted the Humphrey Fellowship Program in 1978 to honor the late senator and vice-president, a long-time advocate of international cooperation and understanding. UC Davis Extension has hosted the Humphrey Fellows for the past 14 summers for their Pre-academic Orientation and Training.

Thursday's speakers come from Tajikistan, Mozambique, Pakistan, Morocco, Kosova, Afganistant, Oman, Bosnia-Herzogovina and China. Topics include "Entrepreneurship in Tajikistan," "Morocco: Beyond the Veil," "Women's Empowerment in Pakistan," "The Balkan Jerusalem: Kosovo," "Deteriorating Security in Afghanistan" and the "Olympic Games are Here in Beijing."
