This five-month cohort-based program is offered twice each year, with start times in winter and summer. Currently offered online, students attend class all day every-other Friday and Saturday.

This program is by application only and requires:

- Five years of professional work experience in any field
- An interest in working with people and helping others
- A mindset that supports success in the program, including an openness to learning through feedback and self-examination
