Foundations of Successful Project Management

3.0 quarter units academic credit, X455.4; 30.0 PDU hours

2.5 quarter units academic credit, X455.43; 25.0 PDU hours

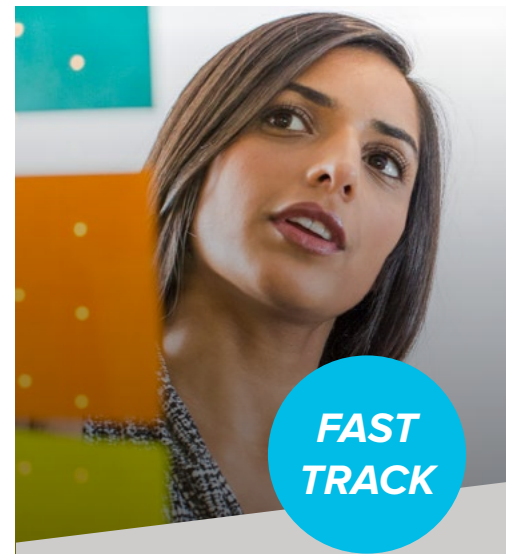
